*1st Sunday of Lent 21st February 2010*

*Deut 26:4-10 Ps 90 Romans 10:8-13 Luke 4: 1-13*

## EXPLORING THE WORD

Jesus' fast of forty days in the wilderness recalls the stories of Elijah and Moses and his temptation recalls the severe testing to which the people of Israel were subjected when they too wandered in the desert. Israel was found wanting and succumbed to the temptations, worshipping false gods but Jesus used the word of God to defeat the power of evil: 'Man does not live on bread alone' (Deut 6:13); 'You must worship the Lord your God' (Deut 6:13). In testing Jesus, Satan is testing God himself and is dismissed from the story with the words, 'You must not put the Lord your God to the test.' (Deut 6:16). Jesus has reversed Israel's experience in the desert and has become the founder of a new people.

- Do you have the courage, like Jesus, to become sons and daughters of God?
- Which of the temptations faced by Jesus - material security, power, prestige - bites deepest with you?
